**Notice**  
**2022 Free Care Guidelines**  
**Medical Care for Those Who Cannot Afford to Pay**

In accordance with 22 M.R.S.A. Section 1716 and the State of Maine Department of Human Services and Bureau of Medical Services Chapter 150, Agency 10-144, this hospital is required to provide Free Care to residents of Maine, whose income fall below the following income guidelines.
