What is You & I?

Why should I give?

When you donate, your gifts support vital programs and provides resources to patients and colleagues in need. St. Joe's is a non-profit institution that relies on philanthropic support to help achieve its mission.

What other ways does St. Joe's gather philanthropic support?

In addition to employee and physician gifts, St. Joe's reaches out to our patients, community, vendors, corporate partners, foundations and board members to ask for support for our mission.

Is my gift tax-deductible?

Yes! The One Big Beautiful Bill Act created a permanent above-the-line deduction for charitable donations of \$1,000 per filer who takes the standard deduction beginning in tax year 2026. Therefore, if you do not itemize on your taxes, you may still be able to deduct the full value of your charitable contribution to our organization.

What ways can I make a gift?

1. Payroll deduction is a small way to make a big difference! Payroll deduction will start in the first payroll period of May.
2. Earned time is an easy way to give! Donated hours will be deducted in October. The net amount (after taxes and deductions) is your tax-deductible gift amount. The value of your donated Earned Time hours will be included in your annual income as reported on your W-2 form for tax purposes. Any number of hours can be donated up to 80 hours.
3. A one-time gift of any amount makes a difference! Just submit cash, check or credit card information to the Foundation at the address below or make a gift online at stjosephbangor.org/employee
